Julieta: He is using the term "scanning" but it seems these are photographs.

Christina Byrd: the scans have similar file formats as photos: jpegs, tiffs

Gil Nelson: Helicon processes stacks, regardless of the method of image generation.

Christina Byrd: Tell him the program is Not Responding and has to be closed

Gisela Canales: The NanoZoomer can create as many stacks as needed the limiting factor is 50um to 100um
